### **TMH Receives Thomson Reuters Healthcare Advantage Award**

**Warren, Ohio** – Trumbull Memorial Hospital recently received a Thomson Reuters Healthcare Advantage Award for significantly improving the quality and effectively managing the cost of healthcare. Only six hospitals across the country received the award for Health and Clinical Outcomes and TMH is the only recipient in Ohio. The award winners were featured in Modern Healthcare Magazine.

Trumbull Memorial Hospital was honored for superior results with the Federal Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) Patient Safety Indicators. TMH demonstrated excellent results with the prevention of several of these patient complication indicators.

The ongoing complication-reduction project resulted in fewer cases of pulmonary embolism and deep vein thrombosis, blood clots to the lungs, arms or legs, and fewer patients with infected central intravenous catheters.

“This award recognizes the consistently superior quality care that we give our patients at TMH. We are proud and honored to receive this award for the third time in five years,” said Claudia Fox, RN, MSN, CNS, Clinical Decision Support Coordinator, TMH Quality Department.

The 2010 Healthcare Advantage Awards were presented in Orlando at the 2010 Healthcare Advantage Conference.
